

Basic Any-Gauge Baby Blanket



Finished size – 3' x 3'

This is a basic blanket formula. To make your own pattern, please fill out the spaces below:

(A) – gauge (aka your stitches per inch) = _____

Now take that number (A) and multiply it by 36.

(A) x 36 = _____ This will be your number of stitches to cast on. Let's call that (B).

Pattern:

Border

Cast on (B). Knit every stitch every row (garter stitch) until your blanket measures 6" from cast on row.

Now multiply your gauge by 6. Let's call that (C). (A) x 6 = _____ (C)

Row 1: knit (C) stitches, place marker, knit until there are (C) stitches left in the row, place another marker, knit to end of row.

Row 2: knit to marker, purl to next marker, knit to end of row

Repeat these two rows until blanket measures 30" from cast on row.

Repeat border (knit every stitch every row) until blanket measures 36". Bind off. Weave in ends.
